**SECTION II. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS AND
TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE**

4. MANNER OF SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 4.1. Due to the government's easing of COVID-19 restrictions, bidders have the following options in submitting their bids:
- 4.1.1. in **PDF format** and sent via e-mail to **disposal.pcoo@gmail.com until 10:00 A.M. of 11 April 2022**; or
 - 4.1.2. in **printed copies** and submitted physically at **7F Times Plaza Building, UN Avenue cor. Taft Avenue, Ermita, Manila until 10:00 A.M. of 11 April 2022.**

All bids shall be presented and read publicly during the virtual/online Opening of Bids. Submission of bids after the designated time and date shall no longer be accepted.

16. SUBMISSION AND OPENING OF BIDS

- 16.1. Bidders or their authorized representatives shall send their bid **via e-mail or physically at Times Plaza Building** at the date, time, and e-mail address as set out in Clause 4 of this Section. After the time set for bid opening, the Disposal and Awards Committee will open and read the bids in the presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives.

For bidders opting to submit their bids physically, they must inform **Kristian Veil N. Nierves** through mobile number **09173052633** ahead of their intended submission. Submission of bids are during regular office hours (8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.), Monday to Friday, except holidays.

- 16.2. Offers not submitted by the bidder's authorized representatives or received after the time set for bid opening will not be accepted.

24. RELEASE/WITHDRAWAL OF AWARDED ITEMS

- 24.1. After the payment of the awarded items, the awardee shall withdraw all listed items stated in Annex "A" within **ten (10) working days**, during regular office hours (8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.), Monday to Friday, except holidays.
- 24.2. The actual release/withdrawal of awarded items shall be witnessed by the designated representatives of the Disposal and Awards Committee and the Commission on Audit (COA) who shall affix their signatures on the "Release Order" (RO).
- 24.3. If the items are not withdrawn within the prescribed period, the awardee shall pay the PCOO the corresponding storage fee equivalent to one-tenth of one (1%) percent of the price of the items, or PhP 100.00/day of delay, whichever is higher but not to exceed ten (10%) percent of the total amount of the Award.
- 24.4. Once the cumulative amount of storage fee reaches ten (10%) percent of the total amount of Award, the PCOO may rescind/cancel the Award, forfeit the Bid Security/Performance Bond, and impose the appropriate sanctions as penalty.
- 24.5. If the property remains unclaimed within sixty (60) days after the expiration of the prescribed period, the ownership of the awarded property shall automatically revert to the government.
- 24.6. Selective withdrawal is not allowed. The awardee shall withdraw all the items within the awarded lot.
